WHAT IS A ROUND TABLE? It is an opportunity for us to meet and have an equal exchange of ideas. We all bring our methods and experiences to the table and help each other develop new ideas and make even better scouting!

AIM AND OBJECTIVES: The aim of the Round Table is to learn new ways, share ideas, see new opportunities, help each other overcome obstacles and share success stories.

PARTICIPANT'S PROFILE: You, who plan, develop or organize international events such as longer hikes, trips and adventures for scouts and guides aged up. 16-20 years. The Round Table does not concern the organization of contingents or participation in larger camps.

The Round Table will be held entirely in English and we therefore ask that all participants will be able to independently communicate in this language.

VENUE: The Round Table will be held in Höllviken, just south of Malmö, at Höllvikstrand www.hollvikstrand.com

You are welcome to arrive in the evening 28 March.

The closest air ports are Kastrup in Copenhagen or Sturup in Malmö.

PARTICIPATION FEE: The participation fee is 1700 SEK and includes food, accommodation in shared rooms and program from Friday evening to Sunday lunch. An invoice will be sent to you by e-mail as soon as we have confirmed your participation.

When you register you also accept to pay your fee no later than 1 March 2013.

Since the numbers of beds are limited, we would appreciate if no country registers more than three participants to start with.
