Participant profile

All Nordic countries are invited to send a delegation for the Nordic Guide and Scout Conference 2018. We expect International Commissioners, Chief Commissioners, and your members represented in the boards of WAGGGS and WOSM to form part of the delegation. Moreover, you are welcome to include national board members, general secretaries and/or others engaged in international, national or regional work in your association in the delegation. Many also use the conference as an opportunity to introduce members to the international aspect of guiding and scouting and ensure succession planning. We encourage you to prioritize younger delegates. Ideally 50% of the delegation should be under 30 years.

Delegation size

The Conference venue can host up to 155 guests. As agreed on the NSK meeting in November this is the initial distribution of conference spots for each delegation:

- Denmark: 25 (+12 Steering Committee and Conference Planning Group)
- Finland: 25
- Faroe Islands: 18
- Greenland: 0
- Iceland: 20
- Norway: 25 (+3 for the coming Steering Committee)
- Sweden: 25

It will be possible to wish for additional spots. Any unused spots will after the deadline be allocated between countries who have expressed interest in additional spots.

Conference registration and fee

The registration for the conference will take place in two parts. Please note that hotel registration is done separately (See below).

- 1. The head of national delegation is requested to send an email to NSKkonference@scouts.dk by February 23rd. The email should contain:
 - The name and contact details of the head of national delegation
 - The name and contact details for the contact person to the conference centre (Bymose Hegn)
 - A list of the delegates
 - Any wishes for additional conference spots

Additional spots will be allocated between countries after this deadline.

2. All delegates are requested to fill this questionnaire before March 1st. This is the binding registration. Delegates who are admitted after the deadline due to additional spots should fill the questionnaire before March 4th. Link: <u>https://goo.gl/forms/os7sF2iOU1aOF0mo2</u>

The conference fee is 3.700 DKK per person. The delegates will indicate the paying association in the questionnaire. Invoices for all participants registered by March 4th will be send to the paying association.

The conference fee covers:

- Conference facilities
- Bus transportation from and to Copenhagen Airport on Thursday and Sunday
- Transport to and from Ungdomsøen
- All meals between Friday morning and Sunday lunch (except breakfast, which is included in the room fee). Please note that dinner Thursday evening is not included in the conference fee and you have to arrange this meal on your own.

Hotel booking

The Nordic Guide and Scout Conference 2018 will take place in the country side outside the small town Helsinge, north of Copenhagen. The main venue, which is also the hotel, is Bymose Hegn.



Hotel rooms needs to be booked by each national delegation. The head of the national delegation is responsible for appointing a contact person to Bymose Hegn conference centre. This person should book all rooms for the delegation.

Rooms can be booked between February 23rd and March 5th. If rooms are not booked before this deadline we cannot guarantee available rooms.

As there is a limited number of private rooms please only book these if strictly necessary.

Getting there and away

Bymose Hegn is placed around 50 km north of Copenhagen. We will arrange bus transportation from Copenhagen Thursday evening and return on Sunday midday. The bus is included in the conference fee.

There is also an hourly train connection between Copenhagen and Helsinge. Travel time is 1,5 hours.

If you arrive early on Thursday we will suggest some sightseeing in Copenhagen. However, many shops will be closed because it is a public holiday in Denmark.

If you plan to leave the conference on Saturday you should be aware that it will not be possible to leave Ungdomsøen between 2pm and 10pm.

Workshop registration

Three different kinds of workshops will be held during the conference: Theme workshops, Sharing and inspiration workshops, and workshops on Nordic Activities. Nordic Activity workshops will be facilitated by the hosts, but we need your help to arrange the other workshops.

Theme workshops

'Reach out' is the theme for the Nordic Guide and Scout Conference 2018. We would like to use the conference as a platform for an exploration of our duty to others as guides and scouts within the framework of the millennium development goals.

Workshops related to the theme 'reach out' will be held at Ungdomsøen on Saturday during the conference. We encourage you to consider which workshops you can offer related to this theme. Relevant topics could be youth empowerment, democratic engagement, guiding and scouting as a peace movement, gender equality, diversity, peace building, refugees and ethnic minorities, environment etc.

Be aware that theme workshops will be held at outdoors at Ungdomsøen.

Sharing and inspiration workshops

One of the main aims of the Nordic Guide and Scout Conference is to create a platform for exchange of ideas and knowledge. Therefore, we invite you to host workshops on topics that you

believe will be interesting and useful to other Nordic associations. This could be related to topics such as events, programme, educational methods, strategy, membership services, volunteer engagement or likewise.

Be aware that you need to include your workshop facilitators in your delegation. Please include guides and scouts under 30 years in the planning and execution of the workshop.
