<p>Virksomhetsplan 2022–2024 Vedtatt av presidiet på Nordisk speiderkonferanse, 16. mai 2021</p>	<p>Activity plan 2021–2024 Adopted by the presidium of the Nordic Guide and Scout Conference, May 16th 2021.</p>
<p>Virksomhetsplanen beskriver arrangementene som de nordiske landene, i tråd med misjon, visjon og samarbeidsgrunnlag, skal arrangere. Formål og rammer beskrives for hvert arrangement.</p> <p>Alle de nordiske landene forventes å delta på de nordiske arrangementene og profilere dem i sine egne informasjonskanaler. Det er generelt forventet at hvert land sender minst 2–4 deltakere til de arrangementene der dette er relevant. God deltakelse forutsetter at informasjon om arrangementer tidlig kan formidles til potensielle deltakere. Grunntilgjengelig informasjon som datum, tilmeldingsfrist, plass og kostnad formidles foretredesvis 6 måneder innad gjennomførende.</p> <p>For å bidra til gode arrangement må det sikres god erfaringsoverføring mellom arrangører. Nordisk speiderkomité vedtar retningslinjer for planlegging av arrangement som skal ivareta disse hensynene.</p> <p>Det skal vurderes å ha representanter fra flere enn ett nordisk</p>	<p>The Activity plan describes the events that the nordic countries shall arrange in line with the mission, vision and cooperative basis. The aim and framework is described for each event.</p> <p>All the nordic countries are expected to participate in the nordic events and to promote them in their own information channels. It is generally expected that each country sends at least 2–4 participants to the events where it is relevant. Good participation requires that information about events can be distributed early to potential participants. Basic information like dates, registration date, venue and price should preferably be distributed 6 months prior to the event.</p> <p>To contribute to good events a good transfer of experiences between the hosts must be ensured. Nordisk Speiderkomité approves guidelines for the planning of events that will ensure this.</p> <p>It should be considered to have representatives from more than one nordic country in project groups, to ensure progress,</p>

a. Rammer

1. Go Global

a. Framework of the event

- i. An open network for young people who want to engage themselves in the global Guide and Scout movement.
- ii. The event is for youth between 18 and 30 years who want to start working, or take the next step, in their international engagement.
- iii. The responsibility to lead the network and to host Nordic network meetings are rotated between the countries during a period from the start of one Go Global-event until the next.
- iv. Each country must have a network coordinator, whose responsibility it is to be the link between NSO, event host and the members of the network in their country.
- v. Go global are held every second year,
- vi. The shape and activities of the network must be based on the needs of the participants, including inputs from participants of Go Global.

b. Aim

- i. To create a wide Nordic network among young Guides and Scouts who have an interest in international Guiding and Scouting.
- ii. Within the network, to share best practices and promote international cooperation and engagement.
