# Learn about International Scouting and Guiding opportunities!

Go Global 2023 is a weekend event aiming to spark interest and teach young Guides and Scouts from the Nordic countries about opportunities within the international world of Guiding and Scouting. During the weekend several activities will extend your knowledge about WAGGGS and WOSM, share some best practices among participants and build friendships between Nordic Guides and Scouts.

The event is in the format of a classic Danish Guide/Scout weekend, as we will have a Scout house in the forest as the primary base and every participant will be allocated a patrol for the weekend.

This also means that there will be both indoor and outdoor activities.

The participants will all share a room to sleep in with bunk beds, so they should remember their sleeping bags.

## **Participants**

Go Global is for young Guides and Scouts between 18 and 30 years, who are interested in more international engagement within the Movement. It is expected that participants have some knowledge about international opportunities within Guiding and Scouting and are interested in their first international experience.

Each country is allowed to send up to 8 participants.

#### When and where

6th - 8th October 2023

We meet at Copenhagen Central Station at 16:00 on Friday and will be back again at 12:00 Sunday (Danish time).

## **Participation fee**

Expected fee: 185 €

The participation fee covers all expenses from the meeting point and back again. This means transportation from Copenhagen and to the Scout house, meals, program activities and lodging.

We are raising funds, to lower participation fee.
