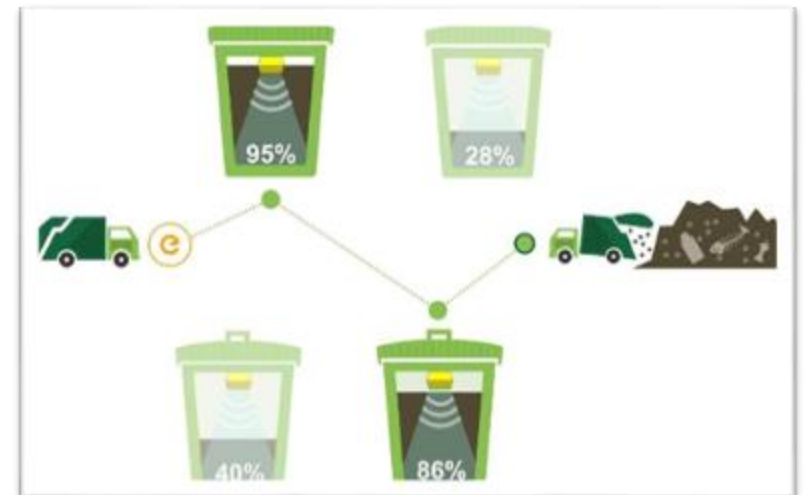

Terra waste collecting company installing 330 sensors



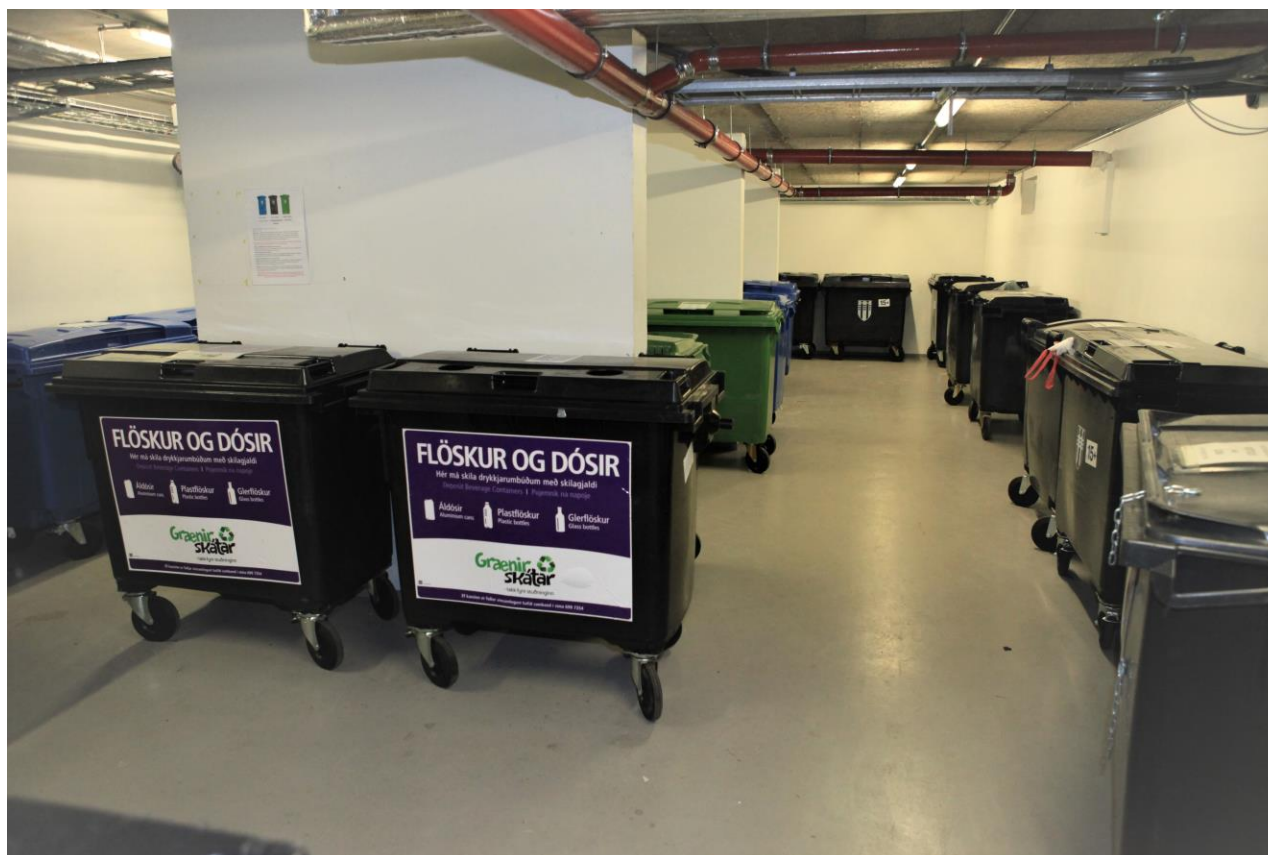
People can give cans and bottles to the scouts at 90 collection points in Reykjavik

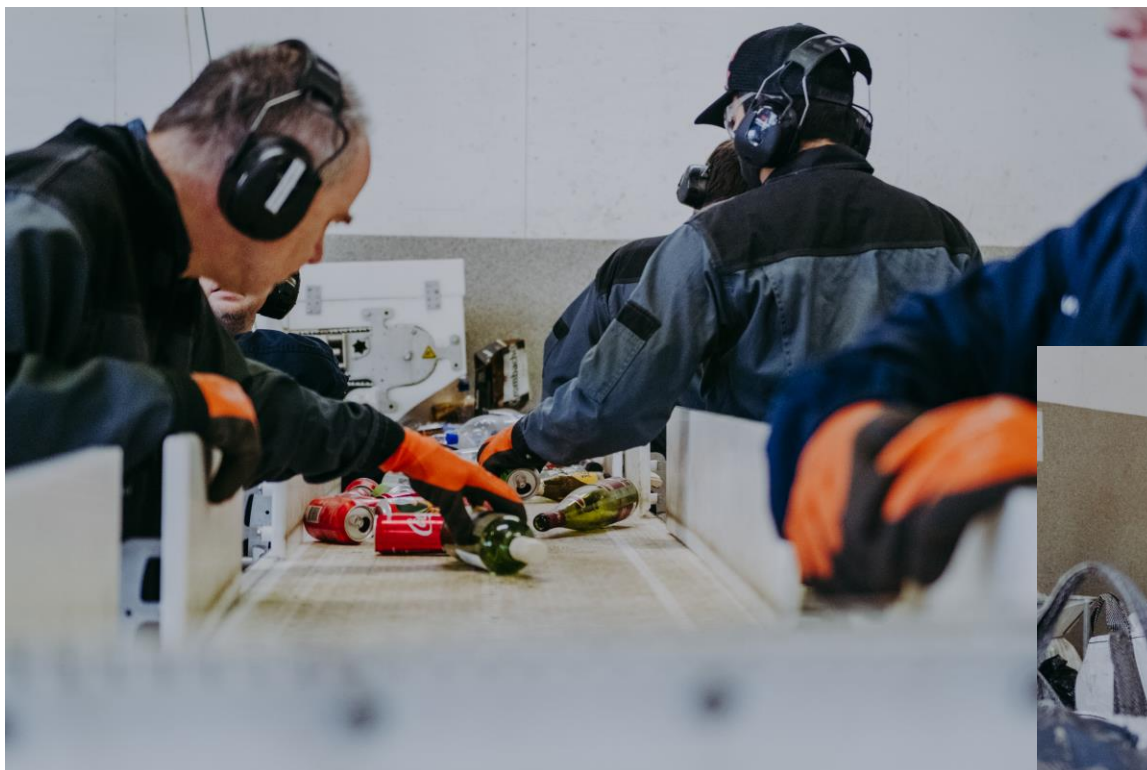
